Membershipduesovermanyyearswere 0.55%, reduced in FY2014 to 0.50%.

Due to costs of major legal cased ue swere increase do 0.65% in FY2011This was a transient measure to cover costs and restore depleted accumulate dunds.

Thetotal legalcostsfor our sidewere ~\$600k (\$300k MAUand\$300k CAUT). Thereforeour target hasbeen to have accumulated eserves ~\$600k.

Planandpredictions

At 0.65% we have been accumulating eserves, \$90k peryear.

We passed ur reservet arget during FY2015 (~\$642k accumulation). The FY2016 accumulation was \$712,909.

At its January2017meetingMAUTCouncilresolvedthat it

"....gives preliminary approval for a decrease in the membership dues mil rate for Full Members from the current 6.5 (i.e. 0.65 % of salary) to 5.8 (i.e., 0.58 % of salary) to take effect September 2017.

This preliminary approval by Council will be presented at the upcoming Spring General Meeting For discussion and will then come back to Council in May 2017 for final approval."
