BACKGROUND & RATIONALE

There is significant interest among many in the McGill commtrii9 (m)10ty

the many changes brought by the pandemic, but also because current schedule hasshorter than normal break between final exams from Fall 2020 term (which enson 22 December) and the currently scheduled of the Winter 2021 term (4 January). This impacts studentsnatrdctors, and the latter must also find time to prepare their courses for the Winter 202 and course prepathey must begin on 4 January, and some of

these programs alreadyn into May.

It is also clear that having our academic term extended into May 2021 fc Faculties is problematic since many students may be starting summer internships, and the Summer 2021 term mu-3.3 (e)-3.9-3.2 ()-mm1.u-3

delaying the start date of classes.

The Fall 2020 term resulted in 25% fewer final examiniations being schas compared to 2019, and it is reasonable to assume that there will be a trend towards fewer final examinations for Winter 2021. Therefore, the pris to reduce their al examination period to gain one additional makeday in the schedule; therefore it is proposed the final examination period will days in length instead of 11. It is also proposed that the final examination be extended until Friday 30 Aipinstead of the current schedule which end Thursday 29 April; this would make up the second day in the schedule. The makeup day can be achieved by the removal of the 'study day', whormally a single day or a weekend between the laysoftal assess and the stoff the Final Examination Period. Given that the new proposal for the Examination Period would involve a start date for Final Examinatic Monday 19 April, there would be a weekend as start between the end term and the start of the Final Examination Period.

With this proposal, Ite Add/Drop deadline would move from Tuesday, Jar 19 to Friday, January 22. The Withdrawal with Refund deadline would from Tuesday, January 26
